The Blarney Brass & Reed Band Music Education Programme is renowned for excellence and provides a first class comprehensive and complete music education programme including one to one instrumental lessons, theory classes and various ensemble groups.

How does the band's music education programme work?

The basic goal of the band's music education programme is to prepare children for participation in the Blarney Brass & Reed Band. Following enrolment, in the first year of tuition students learn how to read, write and play music in the weekly instrumental and music theory classes given by professionally qualified teachers from the County Cork School of Music. In years two and three students continue with tuition, participate in Junior Band and progress through to the Senior Band.

Tuition costs are very reasonable and cover the following:

- Private instrumental lessons (1/2 an hour per week)
- Theory classes (1/2 an hour per week)
- Junior Band Rehearsals (1 hour per week)
